Challenged by much illness in her past, she found her way to self-healing through meditation, yoga and playing the West African djembe drum. Susan decided to give up her career in law and pursue her childhood dream of writing children's books as a way to share her positive outlook and belief that each of us is capable of living a happy, healthy and abundant life.
